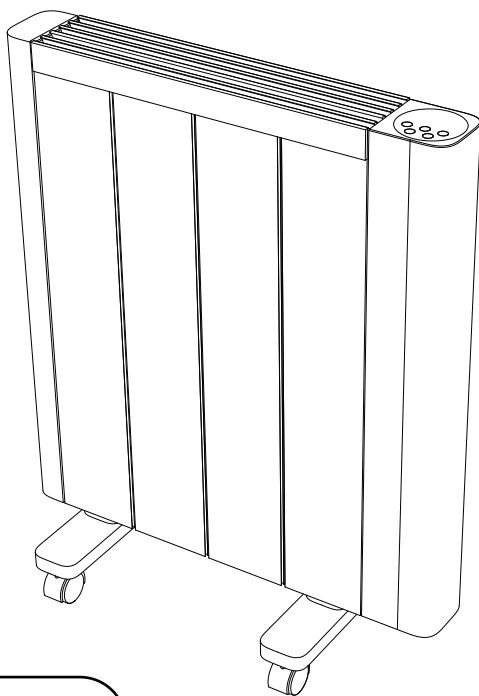

## | GENERAL INFORMATION

Thank you for choosing the Mylek aluminum ceramic heater. Please take time to carefully read and understand the entire instruction manual before using the product and then save it for future reference. We reserve the right for any errors in text or images and any necessary changes made to technical data. If you have any questions concerning operational or technical problems please contact our Customer Services on **0800 091 3171**.

## | BEFORE USING THIS HEATER

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons. This includes but is not limited to the following.

### **CAUTION**

This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge of the product. The appliance is to be operated by responsible adults only after reading and understanding these instructions. Children should be supervised at all times to ensure that they do not play with the appliance. Children under 16 years should not operate the unit or carry out maintenance and/or clean the unit. Any infirmed persons in the vicinity of the unit should be accompanied by a responsible and competent

able bodied adult. Remove the packing and make sure that the appliance is intact. If there is any doubt concerning the integrity of the unit do not use the appliance and contact our recommended after-sales service.

Do not leave any packaging materials within easy reach of children. Before switching on appliance check if the electrical voltage and frequency of the circuit correspond to those indicated on the appliance. Use the appliance only for the stated purpose, namely as a heater for domestic use. Do not use it for any other application as it could be dangerous.

## | IMPORTANT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Children of less than 3 years should be kept away unless continuously supervised.
- Children aged from 3 years and less than 8 years shall only switch on/off the appliance provided that it has been placed or installed in its intended normal operating position and they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children aged from 3 years and less than 8 years shall not plug in, regulate

and clean the appliance or perform user maintenance.

- CAUTION - Some parts of this product can become very hot and cause burns. Particular attention has to be given where children and vulnerable people are present.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- CAUTION: In order to avoid a hazard due to inadvertent resetting of the thermal cutout, this appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by the utility.
- The heater must not be located immediately below a socket-outlet.
- Means for disconnection having a contact separation in all poles must be incorporated in the fixed wiring in accordance with the wiring rules.
- For correct installation on the wall, thanks to refer to 'Installation on wall' part.
- Fixed heaters are to be installed so that switches and other controls cannot be touched by a person in the bath or shower.



**WARNING:** In order to avoid overheating, do

not cover the heater.

- Do not use this heater if it has been dropped.
- Do not use if there are visible signs of damage to the heater.
- Use this heater on a horizontal and stable surface, or

- install correctly and securely to a wall, as shown in this user manual.
- **WARNING:** Do not use this heater in small rooms when they are occupied by persons not capable of leaving the room on their own, unless constant supervision is provided.
- **WARNING:** To reduce the risk of fire, keep textiles, curtains, or any other flammable material a minimum distance of 1m from the air outlet.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Household dust, lit cigarettes, candles and oil burners, combined with the convection effect of electric heaters can cause significant soot deposits to build up on the surface directly above and to the sides of the heater. This is not a fault of the heater. Extensive burning of candles or smoking in the operating environment of this product can produce heavy discolouration within a few months of use.

**Notice to Landlords, Universities, Housing Associations, Charitable Associations Or Other Similar Associations:**

It is your responsibility to your Tenants where these heaters are fitted to make sure Risk Assessments are carried out for these heaters and your Tenant's are fully trained on how to operate this heater correctly and safely. 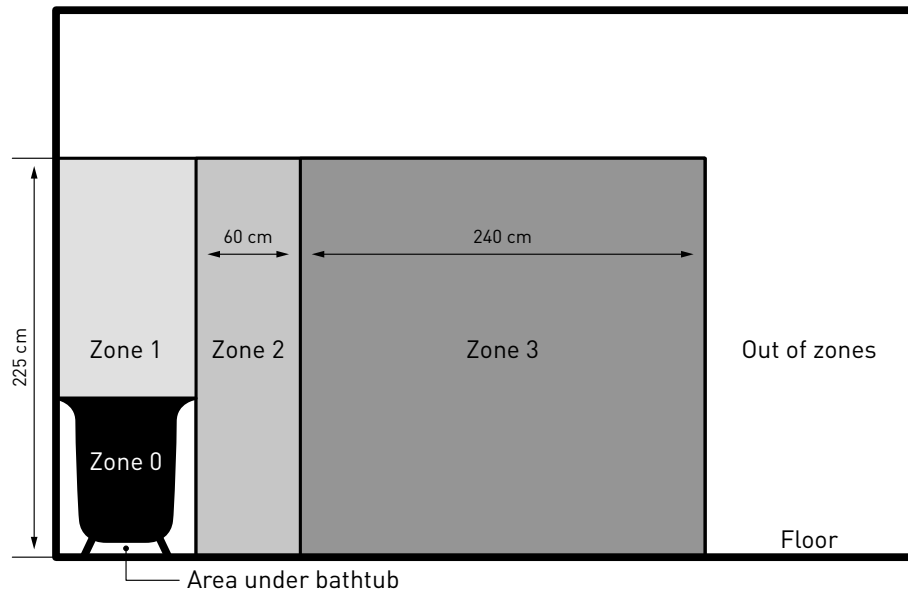
at all times. Not following correct guidance and training could result in the unit overheating system activating, risk of fire, injury or even death.

**WARNING:** this product should only be installed in Zone 2 and above only if fitted in a bathroom according the national wiring rules.

Note: The drawing below is for reference only.

If this unit is fitted in a bathroom then it should be fitted by a qualified electrician.

In the case as of buildings room, a room receiving a bath or a shower and socket-outlets lower or equal to 32 A the circuit corresponding must be protected by a device with differential residual current (RCD) lower or equal to 30 mA.

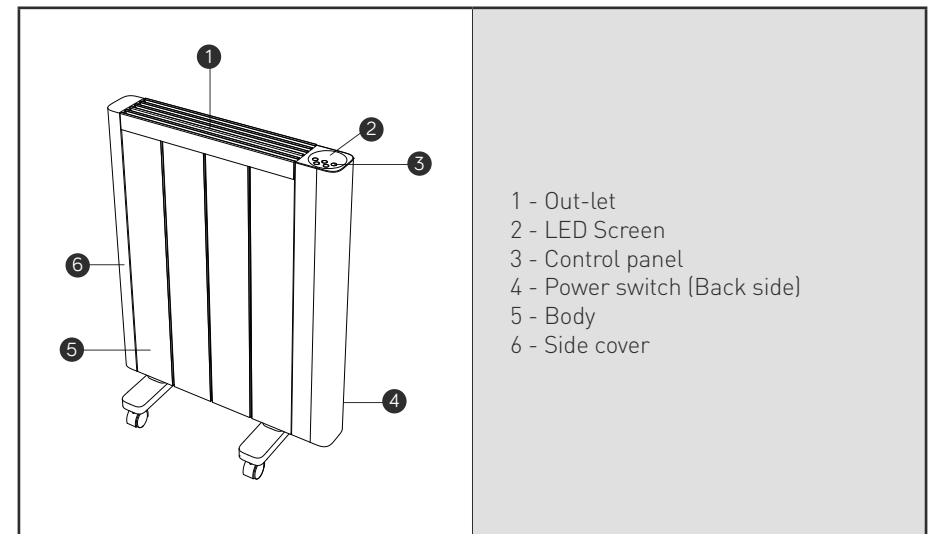

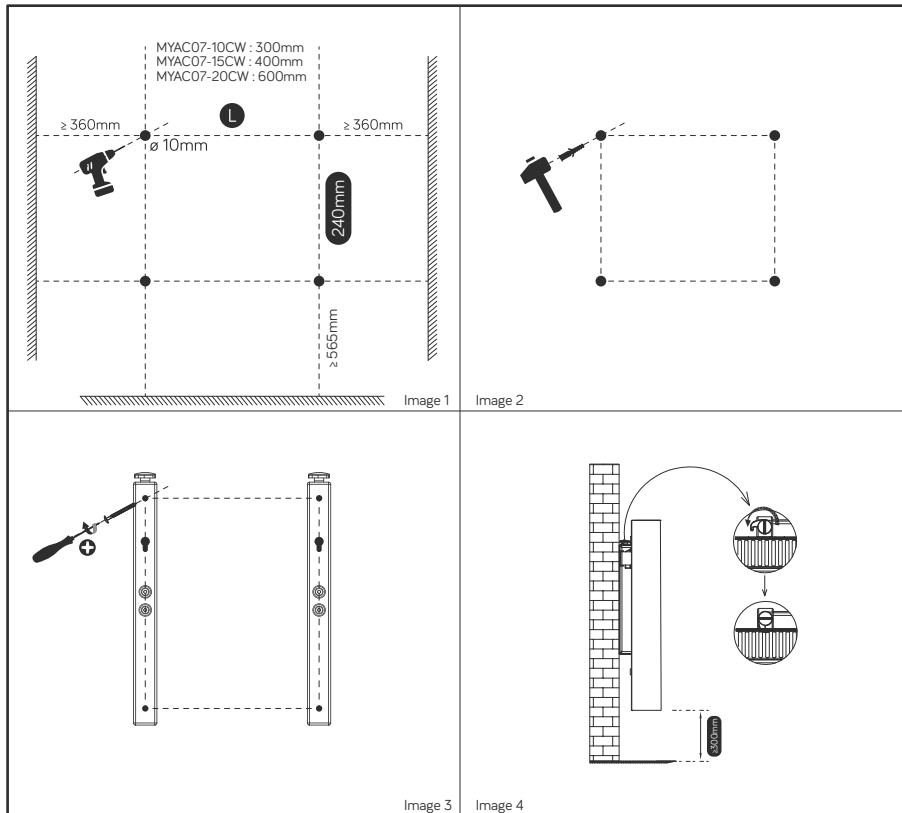

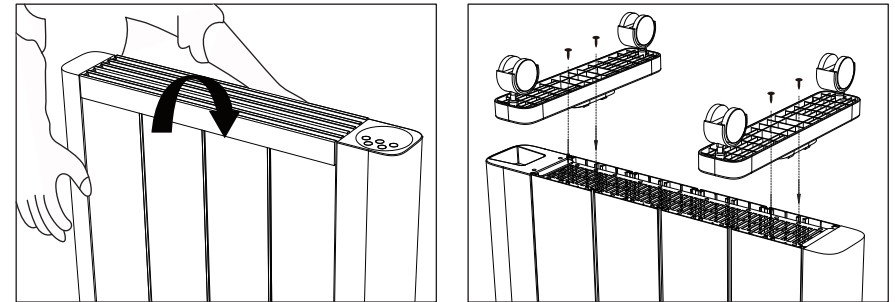
## | INSTALLATION ON THE WALL



1. Drill holes on the wall according to the instructions below using a 10mm drill bit, please make sure you drill the correct measurements to your model number shown below.
2. Place the wall plugs tube into the drilled holes and secure the bracket to the wall with the screws provided. (Image 3).
3. Hang the unit on the bracket gently, after ensuring the unit is secure, and then turn the lock in the bracket as the picture shows. (Image 4).

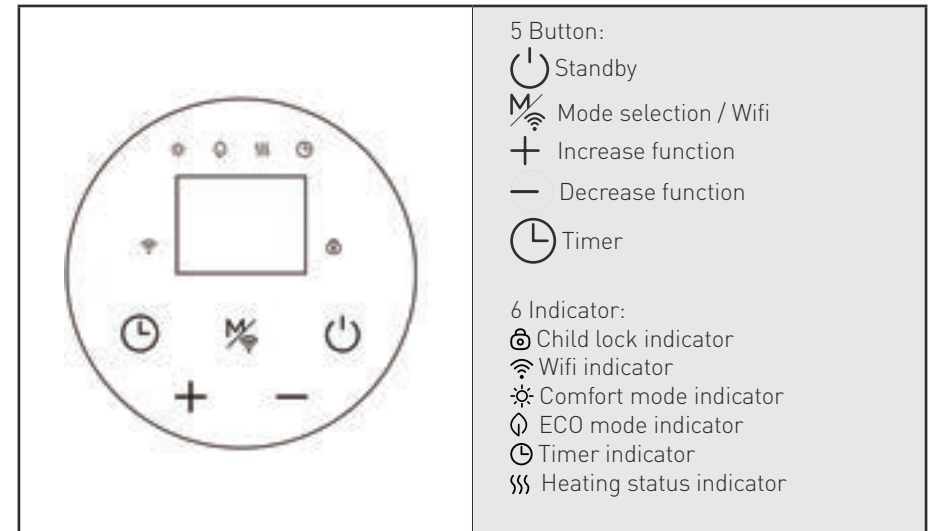
**Warning:** Before using the heater, make sure it's mounted securely on the wall.




## | How to use

- Plug the appliance to AC 220-240V 50-60Hz grounded socket, press the power switch at the back of right control box with a beep sound. The backlight of standby










button  is on.

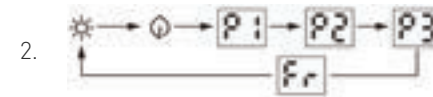
- Press down  3 secs to enter clock and day of week setting
- The screen display "", press  and  to select the day from 1-7.







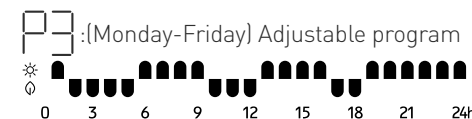
- Press  to confirm day setting and enter the clock hour setting, with the screen display:

## | FUNCTIONS SETTING EXPLAINED














1. Press  to enter mode selection. By pressing , heating mode runs in a continuous cycle as below:



-  Comfort mode: Press  and  to set the temperature from 5-35°C.
-  ECO mode: Press  and  to set the temperature from 5-35°C.
- When product is heating, the heating status indicator  would be on. Under the ECO mode, the indicator color would change from red  -orange  -yellow  color, as detected room temp gets closer to target temp, while actual power would lower gradually to save energy.
- Anti-frost mode: the screen display . The target temperature is 7°C. The temperature can't be adjusted.
- P1/P2/P3: Pre-set heating program.
- Note: If the clock and day setting are not finished, the first time to enter P1/P2/P3 program setting, it is requested to set day and clock setting in advance. If power is off, clock and day setting would be reset.









 adjustable program setting

1. When under P3 mode, press  over 3 secs to enter day setting.
2. The screen displays , press  and  to set from  -  (Monday-Sunday). Press  to confirm and enter hour setting.
3. The screen displays , press  and  to set from (00-23). Press  to choose heating mode for every hour (Comfort mode , ECO mode , show no lights for the unit to operate in anti-frost mode in this hour)
4. Repeat the operation until you have completed the schedule of every hour and every day.








Note: After setting heating mode for hour 23, press  to come back to day setting.

Note: when screen displays , press  finish all setting with display of .

## | COUNTDOWN TIMER FUNCTION

- Press  one time, the screen display "0h" and keeps flashing. press  and  to set timer from 0-24 hours, the timer indicator  is on. The heater will then turn off after the set amount of time has passed.
- Timer quick setting: Press  one time, the screen display "0h", press  each time to select the timer from 0h,2h,4h,6h,8h hour off in a continuous cycle.

## | OPEN WINDOW FUNCTION


- To turn on open windows function, press  and  until display shows , then it comes back to display target temp after 3 seconds (if there is timer, display remaining time)
- When open window function is on and in heating condition, the detected room temp drops rapidly over 4 degrees in 2 minutes, open window function would be activated, while the screen would display  and flash. The item stops heating. To exit open windows function, press  to return the working mode when open windows function was activated then screen stop flashing , or wait 60 minutes to automatically come back to previous working mode, or press  to enter the

standby condition, the open window function would be reset when the item is turned on again.

- To turn off open windows function, press  and  until display shows , then it comes back to display target temp after 3 seconds (if there is timer, display remaining time)

## | SCREEN CHILD SAFETY LOCK

Please note, during any programming, if the unit controls are not used for 1 minute, the unit display will dim and go into child lock mode. To unlock simply follow the instruction below.

Press  and  together to unlock the control panel.

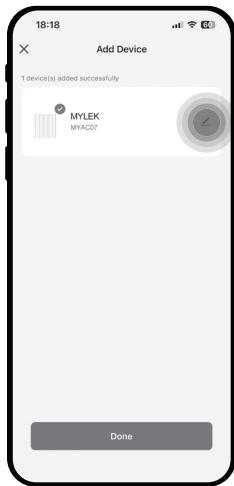

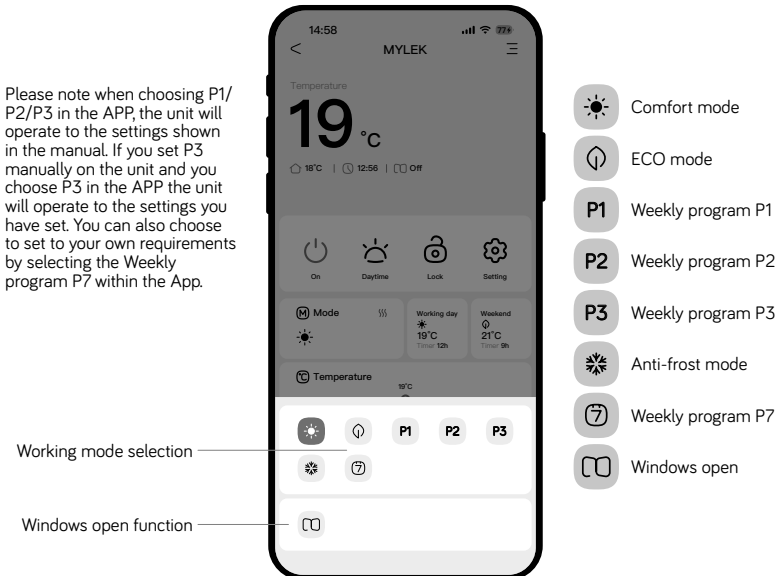
## UI interface :



Temperature correction: Use this function to set the Room Temperature Calibration to the correct room temperature if it is reading incorrect. Select temp calibration and then adjust temperature to current room temperature and select the tick box. The current room temperature is now set.

**Note: to calibrate the temperature, pls ensure the heater already worked for more than 1 hour.**  
Customer can preset usual using way in different situation and name it (can keep 2 quick set).

Please note when choosing P1/P2/P3 in the APP, the unit will operate to the settings shown in the manual. If you set P3 manually on the unit and you choose P3 in the APP the unit will operate to the settings you have set. You can also choose to set to your own requirements by selecting the Weekly program P7 within the App.
